Our commitments

- Comply with applicable environmental legislation and other requirements relevant to our activities and prevent pollution through proportionate controls.
- Integrate environmental considerations into structural design. We will challenge unnecessary material use and, where appropriate, prioritise retention and reuse of existing structures, efficient structural forms, durable solutions, lower-impact materials and design for future adaptability or reuse.
- Use embodied-carbon assessment and other relevant evidence, where proportionate to the project and our scope, to compare options, identify carbon hotspots and support informed design decisions.
- Reduce the environmental footprint of our own operations by using energy and resources efficiently, avoiding unnecessary travel and printing, reducing waste, reusing and recycling materials, and disposing of waste responsibly.
- Consider wider environmental effects where we can influence them, including biodiversity, water, material sourcing, construction impacts and resilience to a changing climate.
- Work constructively with clients, architects, contractors, suppliers and collaborators to promote practical environmental improvements, share knowledge and encourage responsible procurement.
- Review our significant environmental impacts and performance periodically, set proportionate improvement objectives where useful, and seek continual improvement rather than relying on carbon offsetting as a substitute for reducing impacts at source.
